Thèid foillseachadh ann an Earrann Freagairtean Co-chomhairleachaidh Poblach air làrach-lìn Bhòrd na Gàidhlig.</p> <p>Amas agus Dòigh-obrach</p> <p>Uile gu lèir, tha Bòrd na Gàidhlig a' toirt làn thaic do na h-amasan agus dhan dòigh-obrach a tha air a mhìneachadh sa phàipear co-chomhairleachaidh agus tha e den bheachd gun toireadh reachdas structar agus co-leanailteachd do sholar foghlam a-muigh. A bharrachd air sin, thathas a' tuigsinn barrachd is barrachd gu bheil Slàinte is Sunnd mar bhunait airson ionnsachadh, agus gum faod priomh àite a bhith aig foghlam a-muigh ann a bhith a' dèanamh cinnteach gu bheil cothrom aig daoine òga faireachdainn àrdaichte de shunnd fhaighinn agus ceangal nas brìoghmoire fhaighinn leis an àrainneachd aca fhèin.</p>	<p>Introduction</p> <p>This response is submitted on behalf of an organisation.</p> <p>Bòrd na Gàidhlig is a Non-Departmental Public Body.</p> <p>We are content that this response is published and attributed to the author and organisation. It will be published in the Public Consultation Responses Section of the Bòrd na Gàidhlig website.</p> <p>Aim and Approach</p> <p>Overall, Bòrd na Gàidhlig is fully supportive of the aims and approach outlined in the consultation document and is of the view that legislation would provide structure and coherence to outdoor education provision. It is also to be commended that the obligation to ensure that residential outdoor education is provided would fall on local education authorities who are responsible for the overall provision of education.</p> <p>Effective outdoor education provision provides excellent opportunities for young people to interact positively with their environment and each other, building the Four Capacities at the centre of Scottish Education. Furthermore, Health and Wellbeing is increasingly understood as the bedrock for learning, and outdoor education can play a key role in ensuring young people have the opportunity to enjoy a developed sense of wellbeing and experience a more meaningful connection to their own environment.</p>

Bidh Mothachadh Gàidhlig a bhith na phàirt de dh'foghlaam a-muigh na 	<p>Outdoor Education provides some key learning relating to Gaelic and Gaelic-medium education which can be summarised as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Immersion education is a core element in Gaelic-medium Education (GME) and a structured set of outdoor experiences can ensure that newly-acquired Gaelic language skills are deployed by young people in real life experiences – taking the language out of the classroom which is a particular challenge in GME. • Practical, real-life experiences enliven literacy and numeracy in any context but they are particularly important within a GME setting where planned opportunities to use the language in a variety of settings are so important. • We noted that Calderglen High, which provides GME, is cited as an example of good practice but particular information on English-medium and Gaelic-medium delivery is not provided. We would recommend that any support information relating to the proposed Bill includes its application to both English-medium and Gaelic-medium settings. • SpòrsGàidhlig is a nationally recognised outdoor education project which receives funding from Bòrd na Gàidhlig and we would recommend that it is cited as an example of successful provision in support information. • Children and young people in GME are often brought together from a range of neighbourhoods. Supporting young people to build inter-personal relationships within GME provision is therefore of particular importance and outdoor experiences can be very useful in building better inter-personal relationships through teambuilding for example. • Increasingly the importance of Gaelic as an L3 within the 1+2 Modern Languages Programme is being recognised. Outdoor education provides children and young people in English-medium education with an excellent opportunity to learn about how Gaelic has impacted on placenames across Scotland. Including Gaelic Awareness as a component in outdoor education will serve

This will most likely be delivered through funding packages agreed by Local Authorities and the Scottish Government.</p>

<p>Inbhe agus Càileachd Solarachaidh</p>	<p>Standard and Quality of Provision</p>
<p>Tha Bòrd na Gàidhlig den bheachd gum bu chòir frèam càileachd aithnichte a stèidheachadh gu nàiseanta. Mar phàirt den fhrèam, mholadh Bòrd na Gàidhlig gum bu chòir an deagh bhuaidh aig eòlasan còmhnaidh a-muigh aithneachadh thar an dà chuid foghlam bun-sgoile agus àrd-sgoile.</p>	<p>Bòrd na Gàidhlig is of the view that a recognised quality framework should be established nationally. As part of the framework Bòrd na Gàidhlig would recommend that the positive impact of outdoor residential experiences should be recognised across both primary and secondary education.</p>

Dh'fhaodadh seo a bhith a' gabhairl a-steach, mar eisimpleir, beachdan air Gàidhlig mar L3 agus trèanadh sònraichte air ainmean-àite Gàidhlig.</p>	<p>In addition, it will be essential that any quality framework references both English-medium and Gaelic-medium provision and that issues such as immersion practice in GME, and Gaelic as a modern language in the English-medium sector, are appropriately included in assessment advice. It would be useful to reflect further upon how staff might be trained to fully realise the potential of outdoor education. This may include, for example, input on Gaelic as an L3 and specific training on Gaelic placenames.</p>

Scotland has a particular responsibility to support and develop the Gaelic language and culture as part of Scotland's contribution to a multi-cultural world. Consequently, the effective delivery of GME and Gaelic as a Modern Language within English-medium education are essential elements in any strategy to support the language and are important aspects of the current National Plan for Gaelic and the draft National Plan for 2023-28 which has recently been consulted on.</p>
